I understand the following goals of the Summit and will take this into account when planning my remarks:

- Be mindful of the range of beliefs in our audience when referring to God, religion, spirituality, or political and social issues. Some speakers announce at the beginning of their breakout that their presentation will include a specific perspective to give the audience a chance to switch if they would like. Please note that we are trying to build a broad coalition of leaders who can work together on opposing sexual exploitation. We hope that all can be tolerant of one another's beliefs and that we can focus on common ground.
- The guests value open, straightforward discussion of this issue, but do not appreciate graphic sexual descriptions or visuals. We are asking all presenters to avoid showing pornography, even that with pixilated or blocked out body parts. Please also consider the language you use in your presentation. If such material is needed for your presentation, it must be approved by Defend Dignity organizers and warnings must be included in the program and at the beginning of the presentation.
